

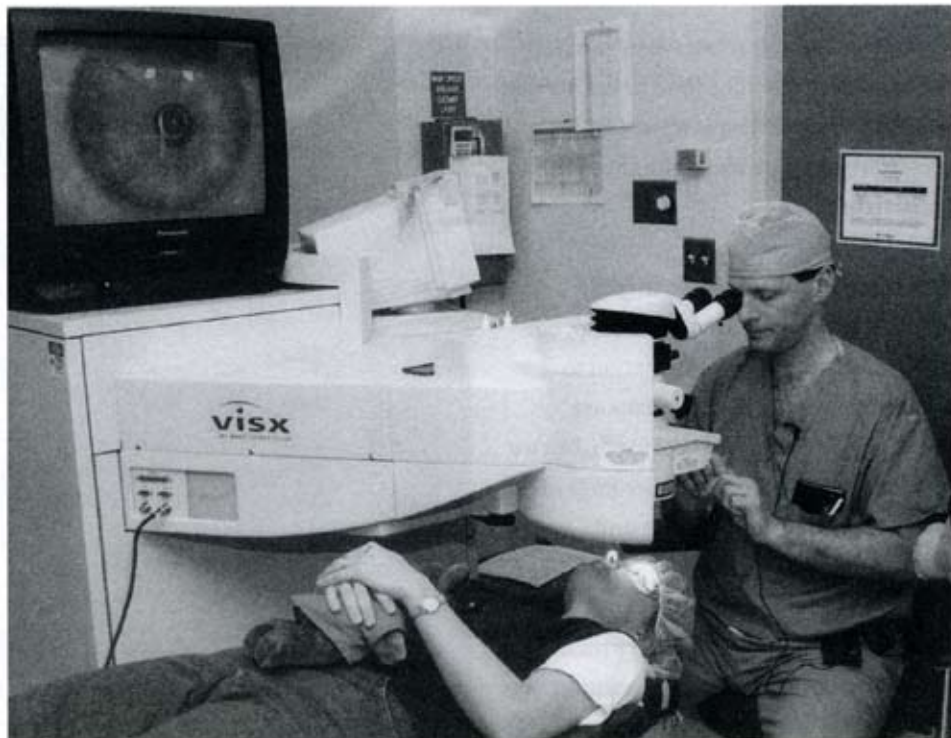
## Theda Clark Laser Vision Center Upgrades to Most Advanced in State
